

Registration

How is registration done?

Registration is done through the online form available on this website.

During the process, you must fill in the requested information and make payment by credit or debit card, Apple Pay, or Google Pay. Upon completion, you will receive an automatic confirmation email.

Additionally, before the start of the camp, information for the first day will be sent from the email address infoescola@rcdespanyol.com.

Once the camp has started, the Escola office located at the pedestrian entrance of the Ciudad Deportiva will be open, should you need to extend your registration to further weeks or handle any related matters.

Finally, please remember that, due to the numerous activities and teams that train at the Ciudad Deportiva Dani Jarque, the available space will be limited by the number of registrations for each week of the camp.

Philosophy, methodology and organisation

What is the philosophy of the Escola Dani Jarque?

The Escola Dani Jarque offers many boys and girls the opportunity to begin playing football, but also to improve their skills and abilities. It is a co-educational training school with internal competition, teaching the values of our youth football academy, such as unity, perseverance, humility, passion, ambition, respect, confidence, and commitment.

The camps organised offer training sessions led by highly qualified club professionals, where players will become familiar with RCDE's successful methodology. These training sessions will enhance both individual and team technique.

Participants will improve their skills and teamwork, as well as understand and apply the fundamental principles of the game.

Is this a skills camp?

It's not a skills camp like those held at Christmas or Easter. During the Summer Camp, activities are not solely focused on individual improvement; there is also time for recreational activities such as swimming or video sessions.

Who is the camp aimed at? How are groups organised?

The camp is aimed at both registered players and those who play football recreationally, born between 2012 and 2021. The camp is co-ed, and boys and girls can train together - except in cases where separate male and female groups can be organised. Initially, groups are formed according to age and skill level; however, if necessary, changes will be made as deemed appropriate by the camp management to ensure that all participants enjoy the experience of training at RCDE.

What is the ratio of coaches to players?

The maximum ratio is 1 coach for every 15 players.

Is there specific goalkeeping training?

In the case of goalkeepers, part of the training sessions are dedicated to exclusive exercises with the goalkeeping coach.

Is it possible to access the club's youth system through the camp?

Unlike the Escola Dani Jarque, the youth football program, both male and female, sees teams compete at a federated level with other clubs in Catalonia and Spain, but does not

hold open tryouts, as it has a scouting and recruitment department that watches matches from all areas and teams to assess potential additions.

How is entry and exiting for participants managed?

The campus management and staff will be responsible for welcoming and assisting all participants with pedestrian access to the Ciudad Deportiva, both upon arrival and departure.

What time do I have to be at the Ciudad Deportiva Dani Jarque?

On the first day, participants must arrive 20-30 minutes before the activity begins. On subsequent days, arriving 10 minutes early is sufficient to ensure the activity starts on time. If you arrive late, the security personnel at the entrance gate will notify the school's management and coordinators so they can meet you at the entrance. Within the facilities, camp participants have access to changing rooms and showers should they wish to use them.

Is the Summer Camp activity open for viewing?

Every Friday from 4pm to 5:30pm, to close out the week, we invite all families and accompanying adults to attend. On the other days, due to training sessions for the elite and youth teams, access to the Ciudad Deportiva will not be permitted, and camp training sessions will be closed to the public.

Can I park at the Ciudad Deportiva Dani Jarque?

The use of the Ciudad Deportiva Dani Jarque car park, regardless of whether it is for a motorcycle or a car, is exclusively for RCDE employees.

What language is the camp conducted in?

The RCDE coaches are fluent in Catalan, Spanish, and English. Therefore, language will not be a barrier for any of the players to enjoy the camp.

Is clothing included in the price of the Summer Camp? When is the kit delivered?

The price of the Summer Camp week includes the corresponding clothing pack. On the first day of the activity, once the students are with their respective groups, they will receive their clothing packs. The coaches will check that sizes are correct and, if any exchanges are needed, they will be provided immediately. Furthermore, as long as the clothing is unused and has its tags attached, exchanges can be made on the second day of the camp.

Are swimming activities undertaken at the Ciudad Deportiva?

The daily swimming activities and lunch at the camp are carried out in collaboration with CEM Besòs, located near the Ciudad Deportiva, and have a certified lifeguard and their own kitchen.

How is travel made by CEM BESÓS to the Ciudad Deportiva Dani Jarque?

The journey is made on foot, always accompanied and supervised by the camp coaches, and takes about 12 minutes.

What food and hydration is provided during the Camp?

The summer camp offers a daily breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snack. Breakfast and the afternoon snack consist of a small sandwich and juice. The lunch menu is prepared in

collaboration with CEM Besós and the RCD Espanyol Medical Services. The full menu will be shared with families before the start of camp.

Are there gluten-free options? Can I choose a halal menu? What if I have an intolerance or allergy??

It is essential to indicate any allergies, intolerances, or dietary restrictions during the registration process.

Once we understand each student's needs, we will adapt both breakfasts and snacks, as well as the daily lunch menu, for those who require halal or gluten-free options, for example.

What precautions are taken for weather conditions and high temperatures?

In the event of high temperatures, hydration breaks and pitch watering frequency will be increased, and workloads will be reduced when necessary, especially during afternoon sessions.

Families will be notified by email of any extraordinary measures or cancellations.

What happens if I suffer an injury or illness during the Summer Camp?

At the Ciudad Deportiva Dani Jarque, a physiotherapist will be available to conduct an initial examination and assess the severity of the injury. Afterwards, if necessary, a medical report will be processed so that the student can receive medical assistance through RCDE's medical insurance policy.

In the event of a transfer to a hospital being required, family members will be informed immediately using the contact information provided during registration. The transfer is the responsibility of the family or legal guardians of the participant

Furthermore, if a participant is unable to attend the Summer Camp due to illness, a medical report confirming their condition must be submitted in order to process a refund for the corresponding week or to postpone the remaining weeks of the Summer Camp.
